Date of Order: 22.11.2017

Appeal No. 96 of 2017 was filed against impugned order dated 14.07.2017 of the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum, Chandigarh in case No. CP-65/2017 filed by the Appellant. The Appellant authorized his son Sh. Varun Juneja to appear in this case.

**Analysis and Order**

1. An electricity connection bearing Account no. 1744/72280WY is running in the name of Sh. Naresh Kumar at SCO No. 131-132, Sector 17-C, UT-Chandigarh as per record of the office.
2. That the meter of the consumer was changed due to reason 'Burnt' the copy of the MCO no. 76/574 dated 18/8/2016 effected on 18/8/2016.
3. The premises were vacated from M/s Ajanta Graphics on 15.11.2015 in accordance with Rent Controller Order dated 20.10.2015.
4. The consumer premises were inspected on 09.10.2017 by Enforcement Wing of Electricity Department and found that only 8.694 KW was connected against sanctioned load of 29.950 KW.
5. Both the parties during hearing mutually agreed to reconcile their issues amicably and submitted a joint undertaking which is reproduced below:

*In view of the decision of the Rent Controller, UT Chandigarh dated 20.10.2015 and checking done by the Enforcement Wing of the Electricity Operation Circle vide ECR No.34/641 dated 09.10.2017, wherein load of the connected was detected as 8.9694 KW.*



*During the hearing on dated 17.11.2017 before the Electricity Ombudsman, both the parties appears and agreed to reconcile the issue on the basis of future consumption (i.e. corresponding period w.e.f. 26.04.2017 to 18.08.2017).*

6. In view of the aforesaid statement and the fact that the parties have compromised the matter, the Appeal stands disposed off.
