The Review Petitioner has submitted that recently it has been noticed that the data of connected load of domestic consumers has certain inadequacy in the computer database for billing on kW based fixed charges and they are in the process of updating the connected load of old domestic consumers and also proposed to update the connected load by self / voluntary declaration of the connected load by the consumers as per the existing JERC Supply Code Regulations, 2018.

The Review Petitioner requested the Commission to roll back the billing of fixed charges to Rs/Connection/Month from the duly approved kW based fixed charges for domestic category of consumers.

The Commission has considered the submissions of the Review Petitioner and also examined the Review Petition. The Commission has observed that no where the Review Petitioner has alleged that the Commission has erred or committed a mistake in the impugned Tariff Order.

In response to the Commission's specific query pertaining to maintainability of the said Review Petition, the Review Petitioner has admitted that there is no error or mistake on behalf of the Commission in the impugned Tariff Order. The Review Petitioner further submitted that they are charging the fixed charges from domestic consumers on Rs/kW/Month basis as determined by the Commission in the impugned Tariff Order.

The Review Petitioner requested to withdraw its Review Petition as it is not maintainable.
