Electricity Department Chandigarh filed a petition before the Commission for seeking approval of Application & Agreement Form (A&A) for LT/HT connections as per the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 and JERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2010.

The Commission started hearings and sent notices to its all the seven deemed licensees to file their respective Application & Agreement Forms (A&A) for LT/HT connections as per the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 and JERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2010.

Electricity Departments Goa, Chandigarh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu and Puducherry all deemed licensees submitted their respective Application & Agreement Forms (A&A) for LT/HT connections as per the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 and JERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2010.

Electricity Departments Goa, Chandigarh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu and Puducherry.

The Commission vide order dated 30.01.2013 approved Application & Agreement Forms (A&A) for LT/HT connections of Electricity Departments Goa, Chandigarh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu and Puducherry all deemed licensees.

ED- Chandigarh in their petition submitted that they be allowed to include AADHAAR as ID proof for release of Electricity connections. ED- Lakshadweep also in their suggestion pleaded that they agree to the proposal of ED- Chandigarh to include AADHAAR as ID proof for release of Electricity connections. The Commission considered the submissions made by ED- Chandigarh, ED- Lakshadweep and other respondents. The Commission observed that AADHAAR is being issued by Unique Identification Authority of India a Govt. agency, therefore, the respondents are allowed to include AADHAAR as ID proof for release of Electricity connections.
