CORRIGENDUM

This has reference to the Final Order dated 30.03.2026 passed by this Authority in the above-captioned matter.

It is observed that at **Page No. 37, Point No. 7** of the said Order, there exists a typographical inconsistency in the time period granted for compliance. The relevant portion reads as:

“...the electricity connection of CA No. 60008114898 shall not be disconnected if the Appellant clears all arrears within thirty (15) days.”


The expression “thirty (15) days” contains an inadvertent error, as the period mentioned in words and figures is inconsistent.

Accordingly, in exercise of the inherent powers to correct clerical/typographical errors, it is hereby clarified and corrected that:

The said period shall be read as **“fifteen (15) days”**.

All concerned shall read the aforesaid portion of the Final Order accordingly.

It is further clarified that this Corrigendum is issued only to rectify a typographical error and does not in any manner alter, modify, or affect the substantive findings, reasoning, or directions contained in the Final Order.
